\$1,000 offered to find, convict wolf poisoner in East Kootenay *Wildlife non-profit puts up reward to stop cruel, dangerous acts*

VANCOUVER – A \$1,000 reward is on the line for anyone who can provide information that will identify and lead to the conviction of the person(s) responsible for spreading poison in the East Kootenay area, likely targeting wolves.

The Fur-Bearers, a non-profit that has advocated on behalf of fur-bearing animals in confinement and in the wild since 1953, is putting up the reward to help move forward the investigation into this disturbing case.

The Conservation Officer Service began investigating when a resident's dog was poisoned, but survived. The container was determined to have the poison strychnine inside. According to media reports, the COS found 17 poison sites in a corridor frequented by wolves, and two wolves were found dead, likely poisoned.

“Someone out there knows who put out this poison,” says Adrian Nelson, Director of Communications for The Fur-Bearers. “And someone out there needs to know that whomever did this has caused an immense amount of suffering and likely broken the law with these actions. We’re putting up a reward because there is no reason for such reckless cruelty toward wildlife, and consequently pets or even children.”
