## **Bear family killed: community increases reward to \$2,500**

### ***Outrage over deaths of bear family lead to residents stepping up reward***

**ROBERTS CREEK** – The \$1,000 reward offered by non-profit group The Fur-Bearers to identify and convict the person(s) responsible for killing a bear family has increased to \$2,500 with contributions from the community.

“Within hours of our reward being posted we began receiving emails and phone calls,” says Lesley Fox, Executive Director of The Fur-Bearers. “We’re directing everyone we can to the RAPP line to submit tips and information on this horrible incident. It truly shows the depths of compassion residents of Roberts Creek and British Columbia have for wildlife with whom we share our communities.”

The investigation into the case is ongoing and anyone with information is asked to contact investigators through the Report All Poachers and Polluters (RAPP) line at 877-952-7277.
